Catalyst Science Discovery Centre and Museum – Thursday 31st March 2022

Our topic this Spring Term is 'A Day in the Life of...'. Key Stage 1 are exploring the achievements of significant individuals including the printing techniques used by William Morris. We will be visiting The Catalyst Science Discovery Centre and Museum for a hands-on 90 minute 'Fabulous Fabrics' workshop. During this workshop, children will learn about different dyes and each child will have the opportunity to dye their own piece of material, as well as learn the technique for screen printing.

Children will also have the opportunity to explore the discovery centre and museum to investigate science and technology through hands-on exhibits, including film in the TV studio, creating a marble run and testing a scarf shooter.
