MAKE A DIORAMA

You can make your own imaginary or real world/landscape

Think about what you will need to make to bring your scene to life!

1. ASK

What is the task? Can you find examples of how others have approached it? What problems might you face?

3. PLAN

Draw a diagram. Make lists of materials you will need and steps you will take.

2. IMAGINE

What are your solutions? How are you going to fix the pieces into your box? Can you hang them, glue them, make a stand for them ?

4. CREATE

Follow your plan and make your diorama.

5. Improve

What works? What doesn't? Are there any alterations you need to make?
