	We will talk about how to be Sun Smart in worship at the start of the summer term and before summer break.
	Parents and guardians will be sent a letter explaining what the school is doing about sun protection and how they can help at the beginning of the summer term.
	New teachers will be informed of our sun protection policy and protocol during induction and through the staff handbook

Shade:	
	When the sun is strong teachers, teaching assistants and Mid-day assistants will encourage pupils to sit/play in the shade where it is available.
	When the sun is strong, EYFS children will be encouraged to play under the canopy.
Clothin	g:
	When outside in sunny weather, parents will be advised to provide their child with a suitable hat.
Sunscr	een:
	Sunscreen use will be encouraged on days when the sun is strong during summer at lunch, breaks, during PE lessons, outdoor learning and on school trips. Children can bring sunscreer into school to apply through the day.
